

## Building Permit and Inspection Utilization Report

Fiscal Year 10-01-2020 thru 09-30-2021

Florida Statute 553.80 requires annually, by December 31, the governing body of a local government that provides a schedule of building permit fees shall create a building permit and inspection utilization report and post the report on its website. This is the City of Mulberry's report based on fiscal year 2020/2021.
